Course content	<p>Interface of the Future – Human-Agent Collaboration</p> <p>This project explores future collaboration between humans and AI. In this pilot course, students co-develop new forms of teamwork with real-world industry teams, where AI agents are not just assistants but integrated as active members of the team. Using service design methods, interdisciplinary teams create hands-on workflows that are prototyped, tested, and reflected upon using tools like n8n – a low-code platform for automating and connecting applications.</p> <p>The course aims to explore early, productive models of human-agent collaboration and generate insights for designing future interfaces. It concludes with a joint final presentation and the development of a shared vision: What might future interfaces look like where humans and agents work functionally side by side – with clear roles, yet tightly integrated processes?</p>
