How to login to PRIMUSS

- To register for exams online you need to login to PRIMUSS. To get to the PRIMUSS website open the following link: <u>https://www3.primuss.de/cgi-bin/login/index.pl?FH=fhm</u>
- 2. You can change the language by clicking "English version".
- 3. Enter your HM-account data to login to the system
- 4. If you experience any problems with the login process please try using a different browser. Login works best if you use Mozilla Firefox.

FAQs

> I registered for the wrong course. How can I change it?

You don't have to take the exam you registered for. It will not be listed in your Transcript of Records, if you don't take the exam. But you can delete the course if it is still exam registration period.

> Do I have to take all exams I registered for?

No, you don't have to. If you don't want to take an exam don't show up at exam date. The exam will not be listed in your Transcript of Records. Please inform your lecturer about this as well.

> My course doesn't have an exam. I have to hand in an essay, project, presentation ...? Do I still need to register?

<u>YES</u>! Without registration, your grade will not appear on your transcript! Even if you don't have a final exam in one of your courses, but, for example, a project, you still need to register this course!

> I can't find some courses on the online registration. Where can I find them?

First, check the How-to-register-information above and follow the instructions. If you still don't find all the courses, contact your departmental coordinator or the International Office so we can help you find your course.

> Can I repeat an exam in the next semester if I stay for two semester?

Yes, this is possible, if you failed the exam. Just register again for the exam in the next semester. If you will not be staying for the next semester, you still can re-take the exam, but will have to do so only during next semester's exam period and will have to re-enroll, even though you may not be here next semester.

> I am on the waiting list for a course. Can I register later for the exam?

No, this is not possible. <u>Register now for the exam.</u> If you won't be able to attend the classes because it's too full just don't show up at the exam. Please inform your lecturer about this as well.

> I can find my course but there is another teacher listed in the online registration. How can I find my teacher?

Sometimes one Professor coordinates a course but some other teachers are helping him and they are teaching the subject, too. In this case, the course is just listed under the coordinating professor's name but the courses have the same content and it's only one exam. If you aren't sure if the course is the right one, ask your teacher which one is the correct course.

> Where can I find the German Courses in the online registration form?

You can find them under the column <u>"General Studies (Fakultät 13)"</u> - you won't find them on the "Courses in English" list!

> Do I need to register for the preparatory German language course (only offered in winter semester) although I have already written the exam before the semester started?

YES, if you want your grade of the preparatory German language course to appear on your Transcript of Records you have to register for this exam during exam registration.

> Are also block courses or courses without an exam to be registered in order to appear on my transcript of records?

YES, absolutely. No appearance of any courses, block courses or pre-semester courses without registration! Even without official exams, the grades of project seminars etc. can only be included in the Transcript of Records with proper registration of the course. This also applies to block courses taking place during or after the exam period.

> I don't have any courses to select. It says: "No course of studies available. Your list of selectable course of studies is empty."

> I can't find the Courses from Department 13 – General Studies. Where are they?

> Exam registration time is over and I forgot to register !?!

We don't hope this question will come up. Please make sure to register during exam registration time. A new regulation prohibits registering for exams after the registration period. If you don't register during that time, you will not be able to take the exam at all.

> Can I apply for extended exam time, if my condition asks for it?

If you need more time for your exams and want to apply for compensation, you can do so. Please see the Services section in PRIMUSS (Applications and Messages > Select application/form > Examination > Reasonable Accommodation). However, you will need a confirmation from a doctor and you will need to apply for that by the end of the exam registration the latest.
