Learning outcomes	During their work with start-ups, certificate participants learn how to apply what they have learned so far in practical contexts. They are involved in independent projects, conceptual and/or research activities or research activities in innovative fields and/or change processes. These professional practice-oriented activities enable them to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • analyze and reflect on their professional practice in the fields of entrepreneurship, innovation processes and team dynamics; • test their own intervention activities and associated methodological knowledge and further develop them in practical demanding contexts; • translate their theoretical knowledge acquired during their studies into professional practice and to apply the methodological skills acquired during their studies in professional work situations; • experience and further develop their ability to work in an interdisciplinary and team-oriented manner - including intercultural work in the case of internships abroad - in complex professional fields;
