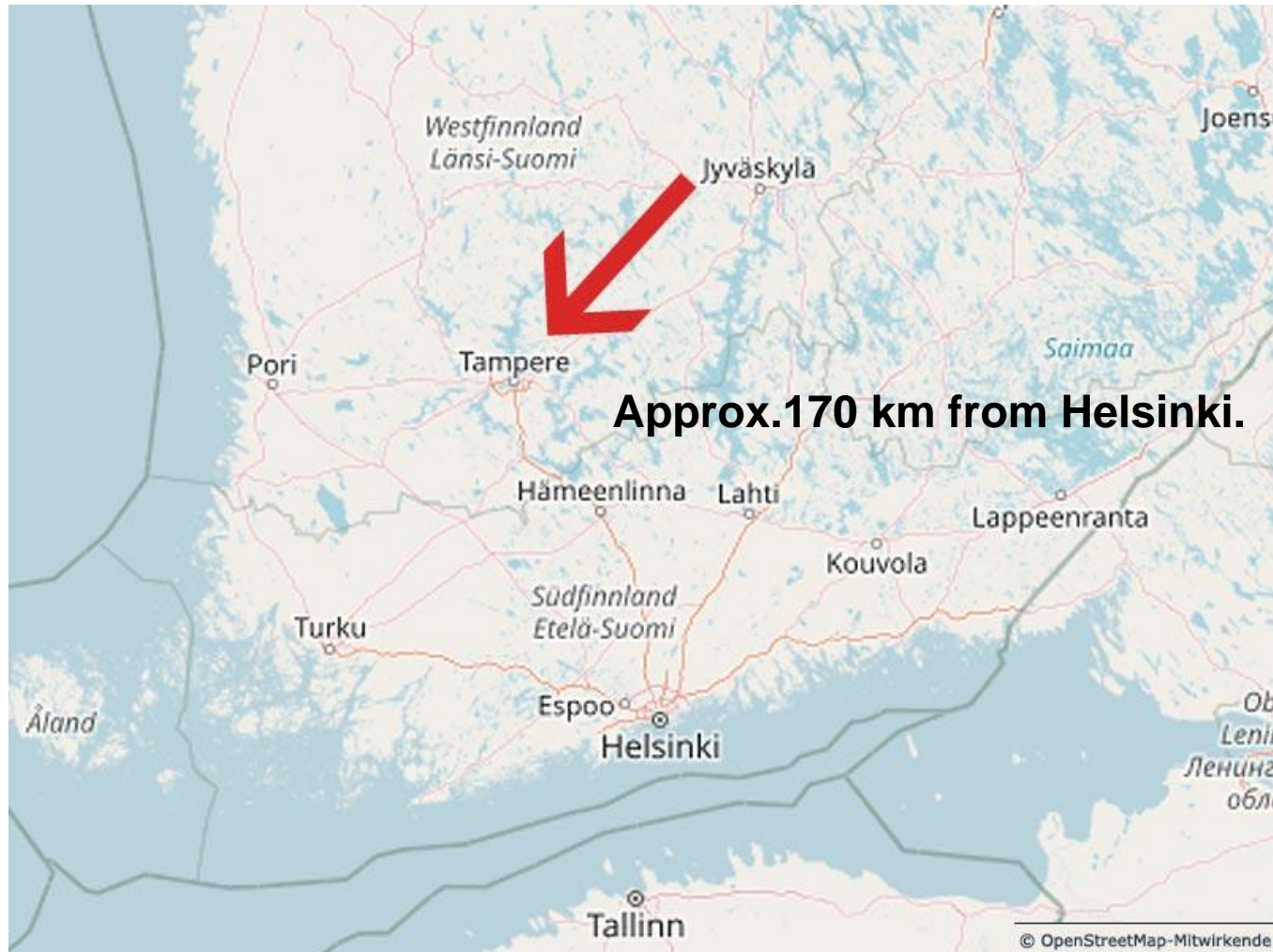
The bachelor's program will be held for the first time from

- Please register in the appropriate event in NINE (NORDIC STAR Bachelor registration list).
- Places will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. There is a maximum of 30 places; the minimum number of participants is 25\*.
- Required documents, to be sent to Tina Grangl ([tina.grangl@hm.edu](mailto:tina.grangl@hm.edu)):
  - Proof that Math I and eight other modules from semesters 1 and 2 have been passed.
  - English 1 passed with a grade of 2.3 or better or proof of language proficiency B2.
  - Consent forms for data transfer as well as image and film release (both to be found on the website)

Should you be admitted to the programme, you will receive a confirmation of your registration, which is binding from that point on.

You will then receive a confirmation of your registration. **After confirmation participation is mandatory.**

Further information will follow from us and the TAMK coordinator. The payment of the course fees will be handled by TAMK directly. If you have any questions regarding the payment, please contact the TAMK coordinator.

If you wish to withdraw from the course within the registration period, please sign out of the course in NINE.
