8. International atmosphere


International visitors feel comfortable in Munich, which hosts more than 500,000 people who come from outside Germany.

Application Deadlines

Winter semester: May 15th Summer semester: November 15th

Language Requirements

German: If you plan to attend courses in German, you should have German language knowledge of B1/B2 English: Confirmation of English language proficiency of B2 level at least

Academic Calendar

Winter semester (15 weeks):

- Semester start: October 1st
- Orientation Days: 2 weeks before semester start
- Examination period: Mid January to Mid February

Summer semester (15 weeks):

- Semester start: March 15th
- Orientation Days: 2 weeks before semester start
- Examination period: Beginning to Mid July





Courses at HM

At the Department of Tourism you can choose courses from the Bachelor of Tourism Management program. Semester 1 to 3 taught in German; Semester 5 (International Semester) taught in English.

International Semester

- Strategic Business Simulation (5 ECTS)
- Sustainable Tourism (2 ECTS)
- International Marketing & Leadership (5 ECTS)
- Intercultural Competence (5 ECTS)
- Empirical Research in Tourism (5 ECTS)
- Elective (5 ECTS)

You can select courses from the "International Semester" and combine them with courses from the "Courses in English" (CIE) list from all departments of HM.

Additionally, you can choose language courses from the Department of General and Interdisciplinary Studies.

HM will be happy to assist you in putting together your timetable and learning agreement.

Certificate

Depending on your course selection, you may apply for a certificate (free of charge) – in addition to your transcript of records. It will be signed by the president of the university and the head of the department that you will be enroled in.



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
